During the last 16 years, Scott Preller has devoted his full time to the public healing practice of Christian Science. He is also an authorized teacher of Christian Science. Earlier, his commitment to ministering to others led him into service as a chaplain in the United States Air Force. He is very at ease working with people of all faiths and backgrounds.

Scott has also worked as a staff editor for *The Christian Science Journal* and the *Christian Science Sentinel*, and as a Regional Assistant to The First Church of Christ, Scientist, working with Christian Science college and university organizations. His articles on Christian Science have appeared in the Church's religious periodicals, local newspapers, and *The Oxford Companion to the Bible*. He has also participated in television and radio discussions on Christian Science.

Scott has had a deep love of the Bible all his life and earned a Master of Divinity degree in Biblical Studies at Boston University. He says, "I feel I've come to know the people of the Bible as my friends and mentors. And because of Christian Science I've come to experience in my own life something of what they felt of God's presence and care in their lives. Unless the Bible is showing us how to be better healers and followers of Christ Jesus, it isn't really alive to us. This is why the 'signs following' that Christian Science brings out are so important." In his lectures, Scott explores how Christian Science opens the Bible up in a way that enables us to demonstrate more of the healing that Christ Jesus promised would be evident in his followers.
